Cong: People became poor, but BJP richer in 6 years

OUR BUREAU New Delhi The Congress on Saturday tweeted that the poor and middle class are becoming poorer even while the wealth of the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) went up by 550% in six years from Rs 780 crore in 2013-14 to Rs 4.847 crore in 2019-20 and that of PM Modi's friends by several lakh crore. Party chief spokesman and general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Surjewala said: "This is the 'Modi model' of New India. India is certainly changing." According to the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR), an NGO that keeps an eye on the electoral politics, the Bajawat Samaj Party (BSP) of Mayawati increased its assets as the second highest after BJP in 2019-20 to Rs 698.33 crore while the Congress came third with the assets of 588.13 crore. In a tweet, Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra expressed concern over the government giving big advertisements in newspapers that cost lakhs of rupees. If the same money is spent in a right way, it can open up the opportunities and employment to the youth, she said.

Gujarat pays homage to family who died on US-Canada border

Shops remained shut and streets were deserted in Dinguicha village of Gujarat's Gandhinagar district on Saturday as villagers paid homage to the four members of a family, who died of the extreme cold near the Canada-Australia border recently. Villagers shared the grief of the local Patel family, who lost their four members, including two children, by suspending work and downing the shutters of the shops in the market area, said an office-bearer of the village, which is located around 40 kms from Ahmedabad. The village, from where a significant number of people have migrated abroad, mainly to the US, Canada and Australia over the past many decades, were a deserted look on Saturday, locals said. A majority of the local residents belong to the Patidar community. Initially, the village was four persons, including a baby, who died on the US-Canada border belonged to the family of Baldevbhai Patel, they said. However, they later came to

fore they tragically died near the border due to exposure to extreme weather conditions. The relatives had on Friday said that the bodies of the four deceased would not be brought back to India. "The bodies lie in a deep shock. As of now, we have decided not to bring the bodies here for cremation. Last rites will be conducted in Canada," the in-law said. Earlier, the Gujarat police had also received reports about the disappearance of two more families from the state, comprising two couples and two children. They had separately filed a report after reaching Turkey on a visitor visa earlier this month. But after an investigation, the police had confirmed that the two couples were not staying at a hotel in Turkey. Meanwhile, the state's Crime Investigation Department (CID) has launched a separate probe into the possibility of illegal immigration racket being run by agents. Earlier this week, the Anti-Human Trafficking Unit (AHTU) of the state CID-Crime was given the task to unearth the network of agents active in Gujarat.
