Court bars Cong leaders from making remarks on Assam CM

A civil court in Guwahati on Wednesday restrained senior Congress leaders, including Assam Pradesh Congress Committee president Gaurav Gogoi, from making any further "defamatory statements" against chief minister Himanta Biswa Sarma until they appear before the court on March 9.

The order came after Sarma filed a Rs 500 crore defamation suit against Gogoi, top Congress leaders Bhupesh Baghel and Jitendra Singh, and an Assamese daily, alleging that false and damaging claims were made against him during a press conference earlier this month.

Civil Judge (Senior Division) No 1, Nayanjioti Sarma, passed an ad-interim injunction directing the leaders and the newspaper not to make, publish, circulate or disseminate any further defamatory material concern-

ing the Chief Minister until their appearance in court.

In his order, the judge observed that failure to grant such interim relief could defeat the ends of justice and lead to multiple proceedings. The matter will be taken up for further hearing on March 9, when the defendants have been directed to appear in person.

The case stems from a press conference held in Guwahati on February 4 by Assam Congress leaders, during which allegations were made that Sarma and his family had allegedly acquired nearly 12,000 bighas of land across the state and were involved in

other irregularities. The statements were subsequently reported in an Assamese daily on February 5.

Advocate General Devajit Lon Saikia, appearing for the Chief Minister, said the court has issued notices to the Congress leaders as well as to the owner, publisher and a staff reporter of the newspaper, asking them to substantiate their allegations with evidence.

Saikia said the Chief Minister has strongly denied all charges. "My client was deeply hurt by the allegations made at the press conference. He has categorically stated that the claims regarding 12,000 bighas of land are false," Saikia told reporters.

According to Saikia, Sarma has maintained that every asset owned by him has been disclosed in affidavits submitted to the Election Commission during each Assembly election he has contested since 2001. "All properties are declared in his income

tax returns and are fully accounted for. There is no undisclosed property in his name or in the name of his family, as alleged," Saikia said.

He further stated that the Chief Minister has challenged his detractors to produce documentary proof in court if they stand by their claims. "If they have evidence of land grabbing, scams or any so-called 'HBS tax', let them place it before the court," Saikia added.

Sarma has claimed Rs 500 crore in damages, alleging that the statements have tarnished his public image ahead of the upcoming elections. Saikia also indicated that a criminal complaint is expected to be filed in the sessions court in connection with the matter.

The development marks a sharp escalation in the political tussle between the ruling BJP and the Congress in Assam, with the legal battle now set to play out in court in the run-up to the polls.

Punjab CM Mann seeks to deal final blow to drugs, gangsters

Says work of every officer is under scrutiny

Reiterating Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government's zero-tolerance policy towards narcotics and organised crime in Punjab, chief minister Bhagwant Mann on Thursday directed the senior police officers to step up enforcement and ensure that the rule of law prevailed without exception across the state.

Mann chaired a high-level meeting with the senior officers - which was also attended by chief secretary KAP Sinha and DGP Gaurav Yadav, and underlined that

the police drives against drugs and gangsters remained the state's foremost priorities aimed at total eradication of these from their roots.

Stating that the need of the hour now was to give a final blow to drugs and gangsters' networks, Mann exhorted the officers to play a proactive role.

Introducing a system of

strict performance tracking, Mann held that every officer's work was under scrutiny and that they would be rewarded for good work and they would be held accountable for any lapses.

The CM also called for a holistic approach which included expanding employment, strengthening education and roping in the education department to check the school dropout rates in drug hotspots.

Mann also sought a state-wide review of arm licences to check the gun culture and immediate cancellation of any arm licence used in crime.

Chennithala is chief of Kerala Congress poll campaign panel

The Congress on Thursday set up two key panels for the upcoming Kerala Assembly polls, with Ramesh Chennithala and Shashi Tharoor appointed chairman and co-chairman, respectively, of the party's campaign committee.

Tharoor's appointment assumes significance as it comes days after he met Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge and former party chief Rahul Gandhi for redressal of his grievances, after which he said "all is good."

Raj govt hints at scrapping the Right to Health Act; uproar in assembly

Heated arguments and uproar were witnessed in the Rajasthan legislative assembly as the state government hinted at scrapping the Right to Health Act 2022 passed during the previous Ashok Gehlot government.

The Health Minister Gajendra Singh Khinwsar stated that the government has implemented an excellent health care program; therefore, enacting rules of the act is not necessary. However, in its written reply to the question, the government has said that the process of enactment of rules is in process.

Congress MLA Harimohan Sharma sought an explanation from the government for the failure to frame rules for the Right to Health Act, which was notified in April 2023 during the previous Congress government. He asked why rules had not been framed. He also

requested a copy of the Rajasthan High Court's notice regarding the framing of rules and the government's response.

Responding to this, the health minister, Gajendra Singh Khinwsar, said that the manner in which the Act was introduced was undemocratic, as the assembly elections were imminent. He said that this Act led to a strike in the state, disrupting the medical system. Under the "Maa Yojana," 5 crore people already receive medical coverage of up to Rs 25 lakh and 2,179 packages.

Hence, there was no need for a separate act," said the minister. Demanding a clear response and intention of the government on the said Act, the opposition Congress pro-

tested in the house and staged a walkout. However, the government stated that the enactment of rules with examining the suggestions made by the stakeholders is under process.

Meanwhile, former Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot described the Health Minister's statement as salt on the wounds of the poor and middle class already troubled by medical expenses. "The statement of the minister is not only condemnable but also like salt on the wounds of the poor and middle class already troubled by rising medical expenses. Our Congress government envisioned the Right to Health so that patients in emergencies, for whatever reason, are not deprived of treatment."

Law student who shot dead classmate, turned gun on self, dies

The first-year law student who shot dead his fellow female student in a private law college in Punjab's Tarn Taran district and then turned the gun on himself on Feb 9 last, succumbed to the self-inflicted gunshot wound

late on Wednesday, police said on Thursday.

It may be recalled that one Prince Raj Singh, 20, had shot himself in the head after shooting at Sandeep Kaur, 19, who died on the spot. Prince was rushed to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital in Amritsar in critical condition where he died late

Wednesday night. Both Prince and Sandeep were classmates at Mai Bhago Law College in Usma village in Tarn Taran.

The footage showed Prince getting up from his seat, taking a pistol out from his bag and shooting Sandeep and then himself in the head and falling down inside their classroom.
